REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE THAT DO REQUIRE A VISA :

Applications and documents will have to be submitted in person the date of the visa interview at the Consular Office. The visa department will hold visa interviews from Monday to Friday from 08h00 to 13h30. The Consulate will be closed on [Argentinean](#) and [South African](#) holidays.

The Consulate strongly encourages applicants to apply at least **30 days in advance** of their proposed journey.

Once all the documentation is submitted, the processing of the application generally takes 10 working days. Please note that a longer processing period (up to three or four weeks) may be required depending on the nationality of the applicant and the purpose of the trip.

****Minors****

Minors travelling alone (under the age of 18) will need authorization from their parents or legal guardians. The "Minors authorization form" must be signed by the legal guardians in front of a Commissioner of Oaths or Police Officer and then legalized with the Apostille stamp by the Department of International Relations and Cooperation (before Foreign Affairs). Please be mindful that all minors below 16 years of age -when not travelling with at least one of their parents or legal guardian- need to state in the form the name, ID, passport and full address in Argentina of an appointed guardian/ companion pending the minor stay in Argentina.
