^{**} Please ensure that you are applying at the correct Jurisdiction which is determined by your city/place of Residence and not the Nationality of passport holder (check the website for more information)

^{***} For NON-SA Passport holders, the passport must have a <u>validity if at least 6 months</u> from date of return and a copy of Original valid South African permit (permit must also be <u>valid for at least 6 months</u> from the date of return).
