Duly filled up and signed visa form, two copies of good quality PP size photographs, original passport and visa fees should be submitted at the front desk of the Embassy between 09:30 hrs to 15:30 hrs, Monday through Friday except on public holidays. Passports must be valid for at least 6 months while entering into Nepal.

Generally, if all the documents are in order, the Embassy may issue the visa on the same day or the passport with visa could be collected the following day from the front desk. Visa applicants, however, are advised to make a telephone call or write email to check if the Embassy is closed on account of public holidays of Nepal and or South Africa besides the weekend days, before visiting the Embassy either to apply for or collect the visa, by visiting the website: <http://www.nepalembassysa.co.za/holidays.html>
