



## **SUDAN**

- South African Passport holders do require visas
- Passengers traveling inland will not be issued visas from/in South Africa, only in Nairobi or Addis Ababa

REQUIREMENTS	<u>✓</u>
Passport must be valid for at least 6 months after return. <b>TEMPORARY SA PASSPORTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.</b>	
One application form (completed in DUPLICATE)	
Two passport sized photo's	
Photo copy of air ticket or travel agent itinerary	
Letter of invitation from Sudanese Company. The invitation letter must	
be approved by the Foreign Ministry in Sudan and faxed to the	
Embassy in Pretoria before the application is accepted by the Embassy in Pretoria.	10
Letter from employer confirming business visit and company in Sudan to be visited.	
Original Yellow Fever certificate must accompany the application.	

## **PROCESSING TIME**

10 Working days (depending on the Embassy)

Please note: Exclusive Global Visas are not obliged to obtain visas or any documentation related thereto on behalf of the applicant or any company representative. The service offered by Exclusive Global Visas is purely that of a visa courier service. Any discrepancies should be directed to the High Commission, Consulate or Embassy concerned. All visa and courier fees are the responsibility of the applicant or company representative irrespective of the outcome of the visa application. Any fees charged are non-refundable. Application fees are paid in advance. Service/Courier fee charges are payable regardless of the outcome of the application once the application has been collected from the said offices.

IMPORTANT: The onus is on the applicant to read and check the details on the visa: Country of validity, number of entries, passport number, period of validity, duration of stay, name and surname.
