





Most (including South African) passport holders require a visa

Please note that with effect from Wednesday 14 February 2018, no manual visas will be issued from the Embassy, all visas should be applied for online at www.visas.immigration.go.ug

Single entry visas should be received in Uganda as the High Commission has run out of single entry visa stickers. Only those who apply online for multiple visas can be issued from the Embassy, Pretoria.

All persons intending to travel to Uganda MUST appear in person for Bio metrics capture, after their application has been approved

REQUIREMENTS	<u>✓</u>
Passport must be valid for at least 6 months	
One application form	
Two passport size photo's	
Itinerary or copy of air ticket is required	
For business, company letter stating the applicant's position, company to be visited and the nature of the business to be conducted	
Letter of invitation from the company in Uganda is required for business	
Proof of accommodation is required (for business and tourist visits)	
Proof of funds is required

The service offered by Exclusive Global Visas is purely that of a visa courier service. Any discrepancies should be directed to the High Commission, Consulate or Embassy concerned. All visa and courier fees are the responsibility of the applicant or company representative irrespective of the outcome of the visa application. Any fees charged are non-refundable. Application fees are paid in advance. Service/Courier fee charges are payable regardless of the outcome of the application once the application has been collected from the said offices.

IMPORTANT: The onus is on the applicant to read and check the details on the visa: Country of validity, number of entries, passport number, period of validity, duration of stay, name and surname.
